


CERTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 1511 OF THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT

Pursuant to Title XV, Subtitle A, Section 1511 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L. 111-5 (February 17, 2009)) ("ARRA"), I, Alfred H. Harf,* hereby certify that the infrastructure investments, attached to this certification, funded with amounts appropriated by the ARRA under the headings "Transit Capital Assistance" and "Fixed Guideway Infrastructure Investment" to the Federal Transit Administration, have received the full review and vetting required by law and that I accept responsibility that such investments are an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars.
