**WHEREAS**, the City of Manassas by Resolution #R-2009-39 requests approval to budget and appropriate \$425,000 of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the Battle Street and warehouse facility projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Manassas previously adopted Resolution #R-2008-91 to budget and appropriate \$600,000 for the FY 2009 street paving program in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission subsequently adopted resolution 08-06-12 encumbering the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account as requested; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Manassas, also by Resolution #R-2009-39, has requested that the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission unappropriate \$325,000 of the City's gas tax funds for the FY 2009 street paving program, leaving a balance of \$275,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission does hereby authorize the budget and appropriation of \$425,000 of the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the Battle Street and warehouse facility projects and the unappropriation of \$325,000 of the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the FY 2009 street paving program.



Recommendation:

Authorize the budget and appropriation of \$425,000 for the Battle Street and warehouse facility projects and the unappropriation of \$325,000 of the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the FY 2009 street paving program.

Background:

The City of Manassas by Resolution #R-2009-39 requests approval to budget and appropriate \$325,000 of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the Battle Street project and \$100,000 for a warehouse facility for trucks and equipment used to maintain the City's streets and right of way. The City of Manassas had previously adopted Resolution #R-2008-91 to budget and appropriate \$600,000 for the FY 2009 street paving program. PRTC subsequently adopted resolution 08-06-12 encumbering the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account as requested. The City of Manassas, also by Resolution #R-2009-39, has requested that \$325,000 for the FY 2009 street paving program be unappropriated, leaving a balance of \$275,000.

Fiscal Impact:

The City of Manassas seeks the budget and appropriation of \$425,000 for the Battle Street and warehouse facility projects and the unappropriation of \$325,000 from its 2% motor fuels tax account for the FY 2009 street paving program.

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Manassas has determined that it is appropriate to use gas tax funds for the Battle Street Project and for a storage facility for trucks and equipment used to maintain the City's streets and right of way, and

**WHEREAS**, on October 6, 2008 the Council of the City of Manassas adopted Resolution 2009-13-R budgeting and appropriating \$425,000 of Gas Tax Funds for these two projects; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved the use of \$600,000 of Gas Tax funds for the FY 2009 Street Paving Program with Resolution 2009- -R and now wishes to reduce that amount to \$275,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Manassas meeting in special session this 6<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2008, that PRTC is authorized to appropriate City's gas tax funds for the following transportation projects and to unencumber \$325,000 from the FY 2009 Street Paving Program.



WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Manassas has determined that it is appropriate to pay for road improvements in the City with its gas tax funds.


