Recommendation:

Authorize the budget and appropriation of \$600,000 of the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for road improvements in the City in FY 2009.

Background:

The City of Manassas by Resolution #R-2008-91 requests the budget and appropriation of \$600,000 of its 2% motor fuels tax account for the FY 2009 street paving program. The estimated cost of the FY 2009 street paving program is \$1.18 million. Of that amount, the City is requesting that \$600,000 be funded from its 2% motor fuels tax account. The following streets are included in the paving program: Brackets Ford Circle, Centerville Road, Church Street, Cherry Street, East Street, Liberia Avenue, Maple Street, Mosby Street, Sorrell Drive, Stonewall Road, Firethorn Court, Timberwood Court, Newman Court, Park Street, Park Avenue, Broz Court, Frank Court, Janja Court, Tito Court, and Oakenshaw Drive.

Fiscal Impact:

The City of Manassas seeks the budget and appropriation of \$600,000 from its 2% motor fuels tax account for road improvements in the City in FY 2009.




WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Manassas has determined that it is appropriate to pay for road improvements in the City with its gas tax funds.
