WHEREAS, the City of Manassas by Resolution #R-2009-31 requests approval to budget and appropriate \$780,000 of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the VRE Parking Garage Project, the Dean Drive Extended Project, and the Maple Street Project; and


WHEREAS, the City of Manassas previously adopted Resolution #R-2006-76 to budget and appropriate \$188,470 of the City's 2% motor fuels tax account for transportation projects for Wakeman Drive, Observation Lane, Prince William Parkway, Wellington Road, Portner Road, Sudley Road, and Fairview Avenue and the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission subsequently adopted resolution 06-09-08 encumbering the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account as requested; and

WHEREAS, the City of Manassas, by Resolution #R-2009-31, also has requested that the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission release and supersede resolution 06-09-08 as the projects funded by this resolution have been completed and the City desires to release the remaining balance of \$250.51 so the City may be able to use these funds to support other transportation projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission does hereby authorize the budget and appropriation of \$780,000 of the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the VRE Parking Garage Project, the Dean Drive Extended Project, and the Maple Street Project and authorize the remaining balance of \$250.51 for PRTC resolution 06-09-08 be released and superseded.

Recommendation:

Authorize the budget and appropriation of \$780,000 of the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account for the VRE Parking Garage Project, the Dean Drive Extended Project, and the Maple Street Project and authorize PRTC Resolution 06-09-08 be released and superseded.

Background:

The City of Manassas by Resolution #R-2009-31 requests the budget and appropriation of \$780,000 of its 2% motor fuels tax account as follows:

VRE Parking Garage Project	264,000
Dean Drive Extended Project	250,000
Maple Street Project	<u>266,000</u>
Total	780,000

The City of Manassas previously adopted Resolution #R-2006-76 to budget and appropriate \$188,470 of the City's 2% motor fuels tax account for transportation projects for Wakeman Drive, Observation Lane, Prince William Parkway, Wellington Road, Portner Road, Sudley Road, and Fairview Avenue. PRTC subsequently adopted resolution 06-09-08 encumbering the City of Manassas' 2% motor fuels tax account as requested. These projects have been completed, so the City of Manassas is requesting also by Resolution #R-2009-31 that the remaining balance of \$250.51 on PRTC resolution 06-09-08 be released so the City may be able to use these funds to support other transportation projects.



Maple Street Project	\$266,000




