





What was the starting point?


- We know from prior surveys that Latino community does not historically ride our bus
- Majority minority county
- Spanish and Vietnamese main languages other than English
- THIs was not reflected in our ridership, good service should reflect community it serves.
- So what have we done?








OMNIRIDE Connect Service


- Soft launch December 2022
- Local route eliminated January 2023
- Operates Corner to Corner
- Comingled with Paratransit
- Use data to determine further adjustments
- RideCo Software
 - App based
 - Website
 - Customer Call Center
- All of this is available in Spanish,
 app live changes so can be any language
















Bi-lingua outreach

- Survey all online in English and Spanish
- Promoted during ridealongs and if necessary done right there with staff
- 152 people took survey only 43 answered all questions
- MAJOR TAKEWAYS most didn't ride Rt68, morning trips most common, mostly going to work, most connect to other routes, most have a smartphone.


